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**INSTRUCTIONS TO STUDENTS**

1. The Examination is only for **Regular eighth semester students** and will be conducted by the institution
2. **No re-examination** will be allowed for these examinations. Students who are absent for these examinations shall appear for the final semester examinations (to be conducted in the conventional mode) as and when offered by the University.
3. The question paper shall be as per the same pattern specified in the regulation/curriculum of the University.
4. The maximum mark for the examination of each subject will be **100**. The student shall write only for **70 marks**.
5. The maximum duration of the examination will be **2 hours and 15 minutes**.
6. If any student have inconvenience in writing the examination from his/her house/location due to connectivity issues, should be informed to the concerned HOD.
7. After valuation of the answer scripts, the marks of students will be published/ circulated among the concerned students. If any grievance in this regard shall be intimated to the concerned HOD.
8. The marks entered by the faculty (out of 100) will be treated by the University as out of 70. University will convert this mark to a scale of 100 by multiplying with 1.42857.
9. This mark will be treated as the **final mark of the end semester examination**. **This mark will then be normalized** on the basis of performance of the student up to the previous semesters {Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) up to S7 for S8 students} available on the date of processing result.
10. The student has **the option to improve the grade of the particular subject** by appearing the end semester examination in the next available chance, which will be treated as his/her first chance. Provisions for Improvement will not be available in any other chance thereafter
